HearForm™ & NOAH™



HearForm 10 and NOAH

HearForm is now NOAH compatible and officially a member of HIMSA. HearForm connects to NOAH through an optional module available from our partners at <https://www.counselear.com/HearForm>. An explanation of fees for the module can be found at the end of this document.

The following audiometric data is currently being passed between HearForm and NOAH:

1. Air Conduction (including masked and no response)
2. Bone Conduction (including masked and no response)
3. MCL Tone (currently only for CounselEAR)
4. UCL Tone (currently only for CounselEAR)
5. Tympanometry (Type, Pressure, Compliance, ECV, Gradient)

The newest version of the Synergy module can now transfer Speech data between NOAH and CounselEAR or HearForm. The following fields can now be transferred:

SRT: dB and Mask for Right and Left
MCL: dB for Right and Left
UCL: db for Right and Left
WR: %, dB, and Mask for Right and Left
WRN: %, dB, and Noise for Right and Left

CounselEAR is adding new import capabilities to a future Module that will pull in a number of other audiometric fields.

Requirements (for the Host computer only)

(Each guest "Work Station" can run HearForm on FileMaker Pro 9, 10 or 11.) On the Main Host (Server) however, the Synergy module currently works with FileMaker Pro 9 and 10 only. **It does NOT work with FileMaker Pro 11 (on the server.)** FileMaker is working on a fix to allow connectivity with version 11.

HearForm can temporarily downgrade your Host/Server to version 9 or 10 at no charge.

The Module works with both 32bit and 64bit systems.

Important: If you host your files on FileMaker Server software, you will not be able to use this product unless you upgrade to FileMaker Server Advanced. Please call HearForm to discuss your options. 888-453-8806.

Setting up your Computer to Transfer Data

It is assumed that you have already installed NOAH on the computer that will be used for data transfer. (*This process will work with NOAH 3.6.1 or later client installations.*)



In order for HearForm to link with NOAH, you will need to install two files.

CounselEAR Synergy™ (NOAH Module)

This should be installed on the same computer(s) on which the NOAH client has been installed. (*CounselEAR Synergy will work with NOAH 3.6.1 or later client installations.*)

HearForm Gateway

The HearForm Gateway component should be installed on the same computer on which HearForm is being Hosted (The Server.)

Technical Explanation: The HearForm Gateway installation does the following...

- Installs as a Windows service called HearForm Gateway which allows ODBC communication between the NOAH client and the FileMaker database
- Installs DataDirect ODBC driver
- Creates Windows Firewall exception to open communication to the FileMaker database
- Modifies Windows Registry to enable ODBC communication within FileMaker

Note: While we do not support NOAH software installation or issues, HearForm Technical Support can help you with the installation of HearForm and CounselEAR modules. Please feel free to call 888-453-8806 to arrange a HearForm Connection installation appointment.

CounselEAR Synergy™ (NOAH Module)

The download of Synergy will take approximately 2-3 minutes. (The file is less than 7 megabytes.)

Your current version of NOAH will be automatically checked. Synergy is compatible with NOAH 3.6 and greater. To upgrade your version of NOAH follow the prompts on the screen or [Click Here](#).

HearForm Gateway

The download of the HearForm Gateway will take approximately 5-7 minutes. (The file is less than 18 megabytes.)

Following completion of the download, double click the file "Setup.exe" or select "Run" when prompted.

Once the installation process has completed, you will receive a pop-up confirmation message.

Using the System

Open NOAH and HearForm10.

The HearForm Gateway allows...

- Transfer to NOAH from HearForm
- Transfer to HearForm from NOAH

In both cases, you must add a new client to NOAH before you can *Export to* or *Import from* HearForm. The client/patient *does not* need to be in HearForm first, but must already be in NOAH.

HearForm's connection with NOAH is based upon the current client chosen from the NOAH client register. The screenshot below shows the creation of a new NOAH client. We have added data to many of the 25 editable fields; however, only the patient's first & last name and date of birth are required.

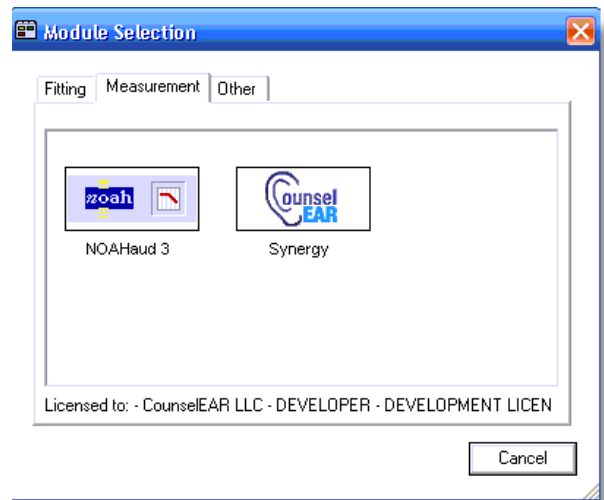

Add a new client/patient (or open an existing client) and then click the “Open Module Selection” item in the top toolbar.

Click the Measurement tab and you should see the Synergy module. Double-click this icon to open the module.

(Note: Hearing instrument manufacturers are located under the “Fitting” tab)



There are four tabs within Synergy:

Module Configuration

- Specify connection information for CounselEAR as well as HearForm
- The module requires that you have a CounselEAR user account in order to use any of the features

Import Data into NOAH

- Import audiometric data from HearForm or CounselEAR into NOAH
- Once the data has been imported you can verify everything is in the system properly by viewing it thru NoahAUD, which is another module that comes by default with the NOAH client installation

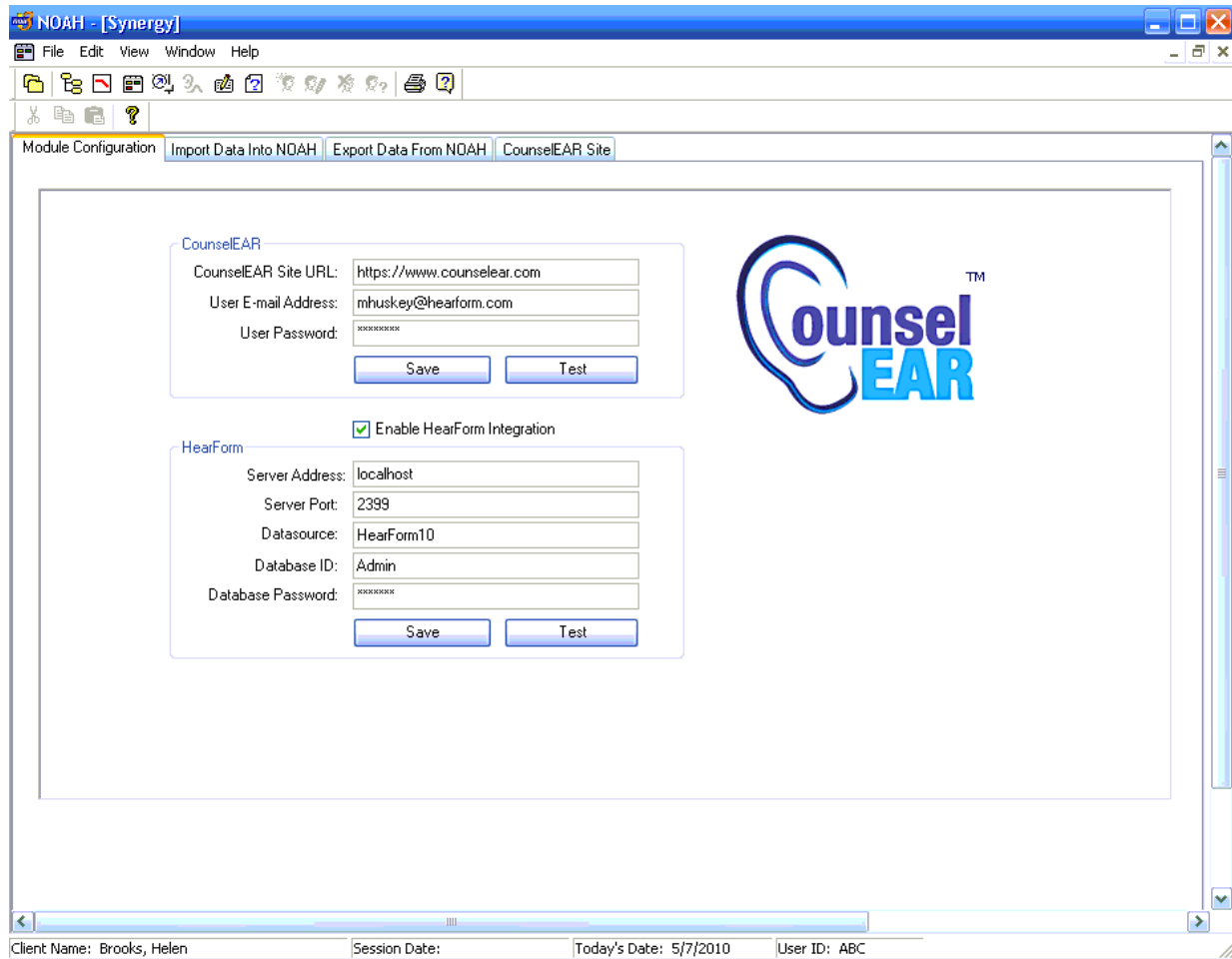
Export Data from NOAH

- Export audiometric data from NOAH to HearForm or CounselEAR
- An option exists to create the patient in HearForm or CounselEAR if it does not already exist

- Used primarily to work with the export from NOAH to CounselEAR

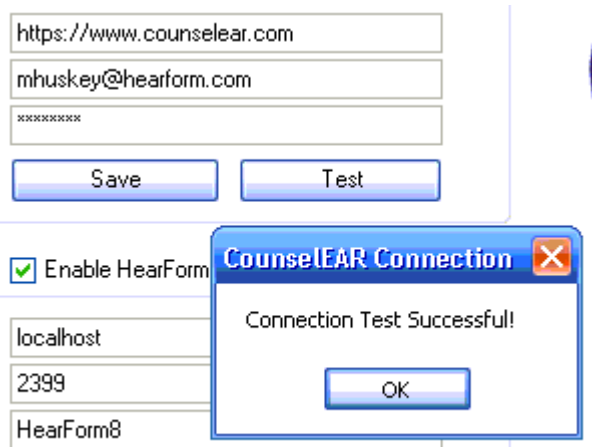

(You will only need to do this the first time you use Synergy.)

Check the box “Enable HearForm Integration.”

Fill in the remaining fields as follows...

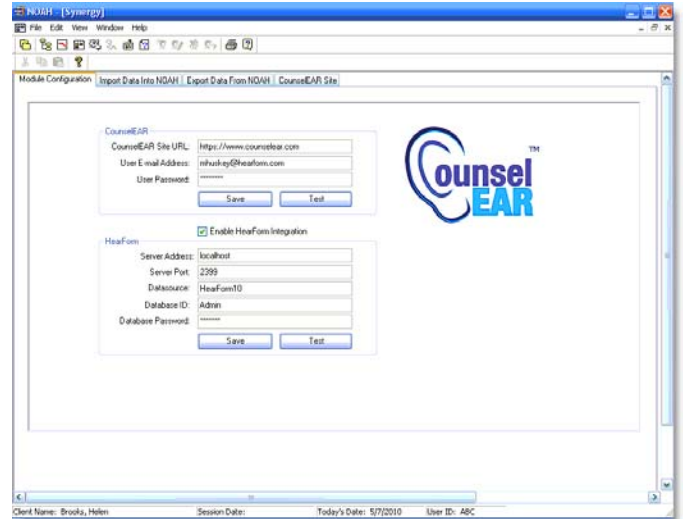

Once the patient is matched in HearForm, HearForm Audiometric data is displayed in the Right and Left Fields near the bottom.

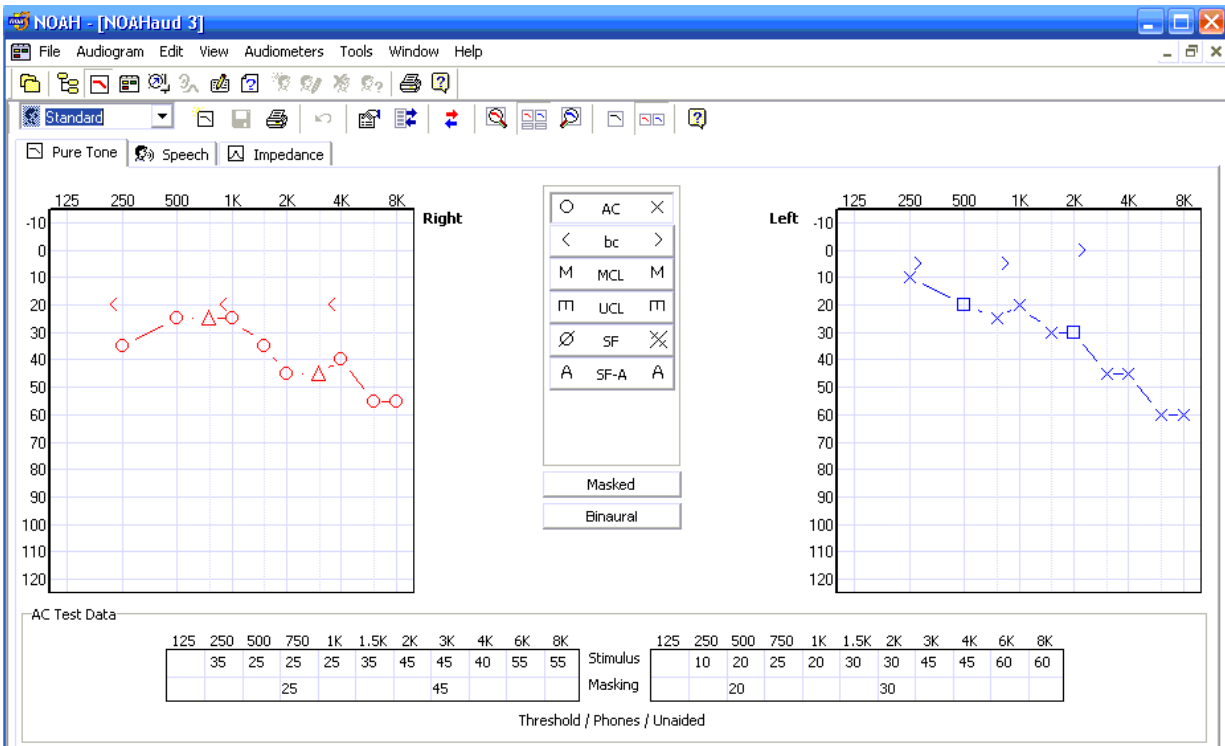

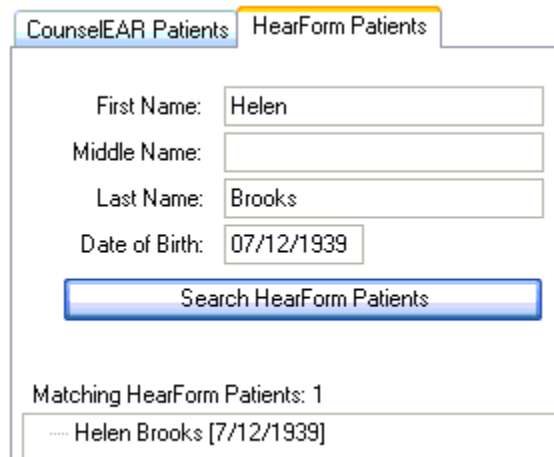
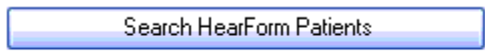
If Starting a New Patient Visit Within CounselEAR:

4. Click the "Import Data To NOAH" tab (top of screen) Then "Import Patient Visit Data into NOAH" to complete the transfer. (bottom of screen)

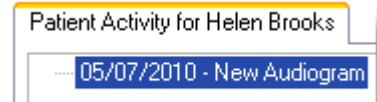

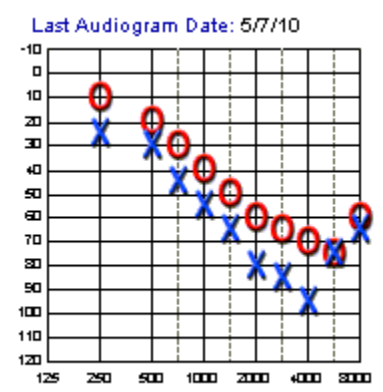

Yes, CounselEAR Synergy (our NOAH module) allows your data to transfer seamlessly between CounselEAR and NOAH. CounselEAR Synergy comes at no extra charge and can be easily download from the Home page.

Will CounselEAR work with my audiometer?

If you use a NOAH compatible audiometer, you can use CounselEAR Synergy within NOAH. If you do not use a NOAH compatible audiometer, we suggest setting up a laptop or desktop computer near your audiometer. This way, you can enter your audiometric data while you test. You are then only seconds away from creating customized counseling summaries, your professional audiologic reports, as well as transferring your data into NOAH.

Can I use CounselEAR to create other types of reports?

Yes, you can choose to remove the audiogram and associated boxes from the Professional Report. You can set this preference for all reports or for individual patients. This may be beneficial to you in the following ways:

1. Creating Tinnitus, Vestibular, CAPD, Electrophysiology, and Hearing Aid evaluation reports.
2. Printing the audiogram via your current audiometer then using CounselEAR to create the official report, as well as the fax cover sheet and cover letter.
